The Valley Sanitary District's (VSD) Training & Office Building Project is designed to upgrade its infrastructure to accommodate the needs of an expanding workforce and fostering educational collaborations. This project is a key investment in human resources and community engagement, reinforcing VSD's commitment to maintaining its leadership in wastewater management expertise and service.

The need for additional space arose when VSD's previous training area was repurposed as office space during the pandemic. With VSD's team and operational scope expanding, this new building will serve as a much-needed permanent solution. It is designed not only to accommodate staff but also to enhance collaborations with local academic institutions, providing opportunities to educate future generations and develop industry experts in the wastewater field.

The initial phase is estimated at \$1.5 million which includes planning, environmental assessments, permitting and design. Construction costs are estimated at \$10 million.
